Congrats to Anita* for Shaking the Keys! After building up savings, budgeting, applying and qualifying for housing, Anita has moved into her own apartment in Arlington, VA with her two young children. <u>Watch the video</u> of Anita's move-in day at her apartment!

Before Anita came to Carpenter's Shelter, she was staying with a family member. Due to a family conflict, she could no longer stay there and arrived at Carpenter's Shelter. Anita's case manager, Dyneka M., helped her to obtain childcare and a new SSI debit card. Anita and her two children lived at Carpenter's Shelter for about seven months. Anita was able to move into her new apartment due to the Rapid Re-Housing program and help from her housing locator, Lisa F.

Anita is grateful that she has the support from Carpenter's Shelter. She has received clothing for herself and her children, sheets, water bottles and diapers for daycare, and basic home necessities like an air mattress, kitchen utensils, dinner plates and cups.

When Dyneeka came to drop off home items at the apartment, Anita asked her for help in putting up the shower curtain. Anita had grown up in foster care and had never changed her own shower curtain before. This moment of being in her own apartment was brand new to her.

Anita had moments where she wanted to give up, but Carpenter's Shelter staff encouraged her that things will fall into place. She kept going, and now is settling into a new apartment due to her own determination and the dedicated work of Carpenter's Shelter staff.
